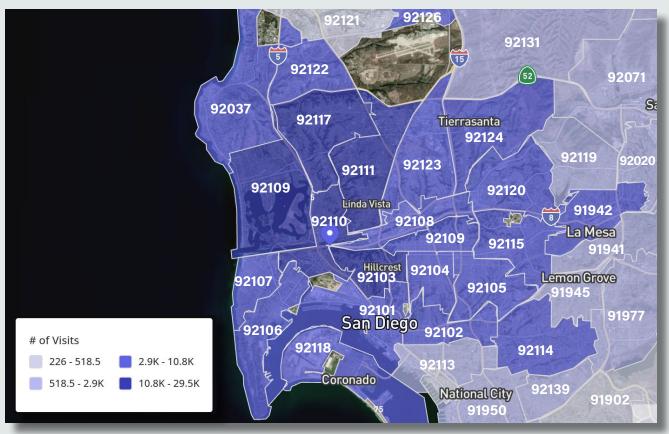

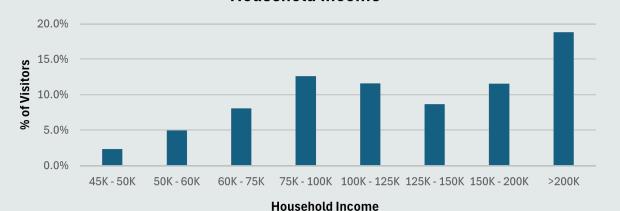

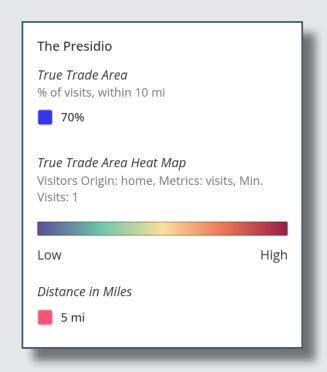

# Customer Location Map

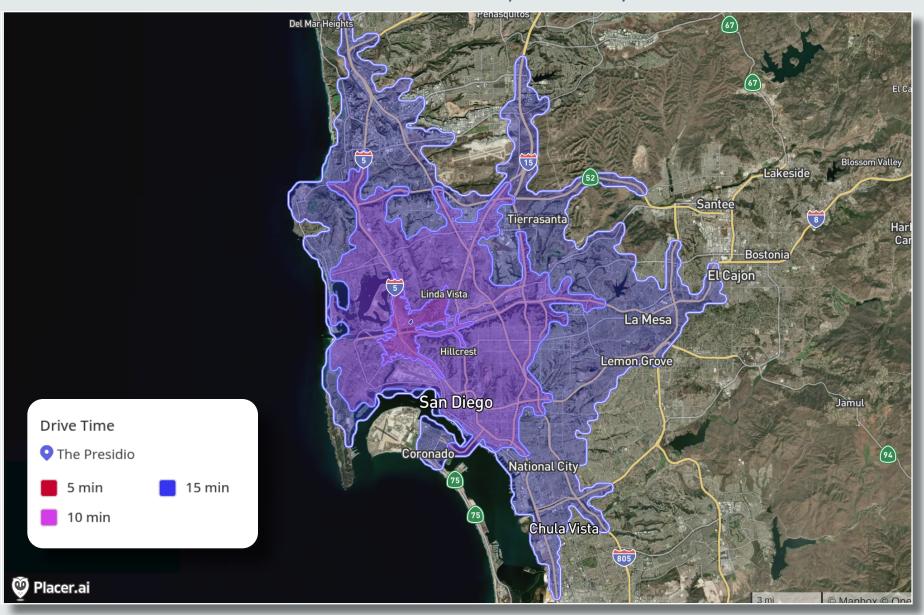
This heat map represents where people reside that have visited the property at least 1 time in the past year.

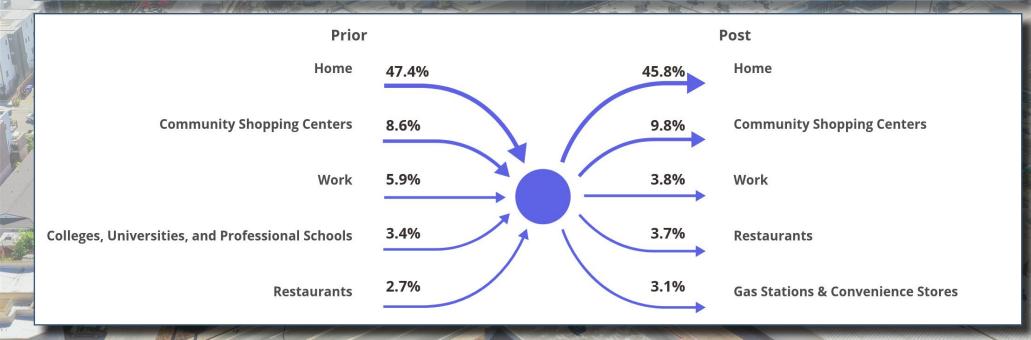

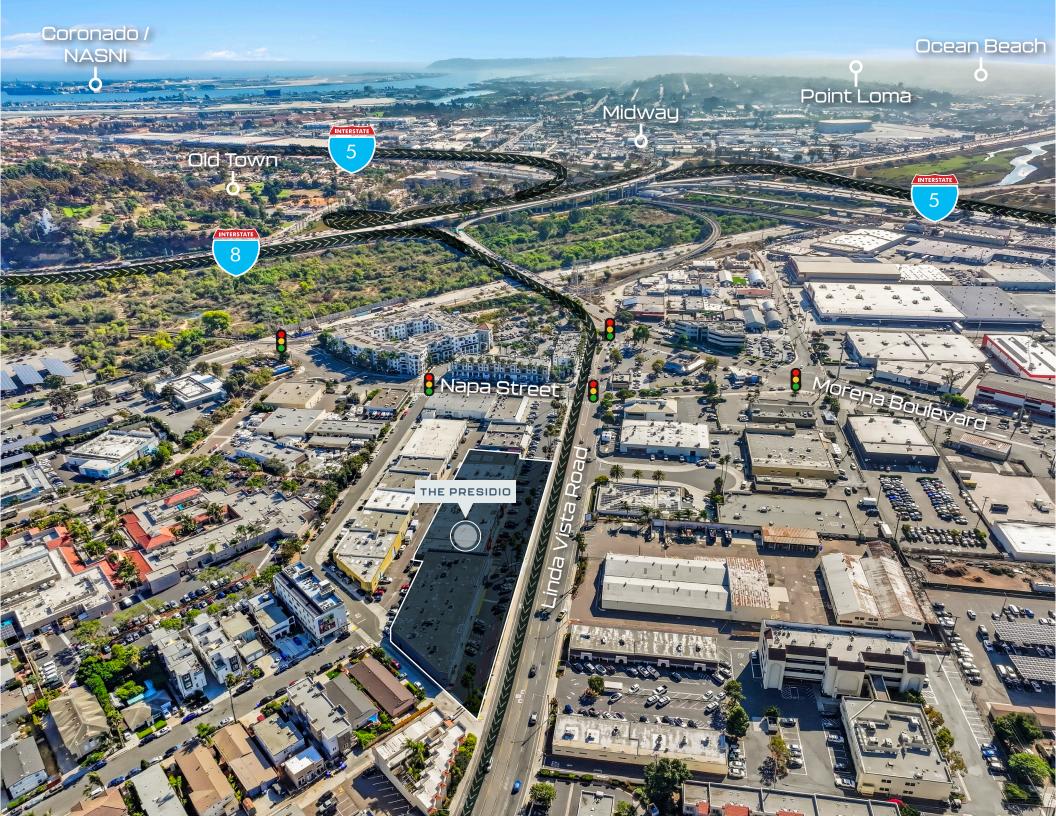

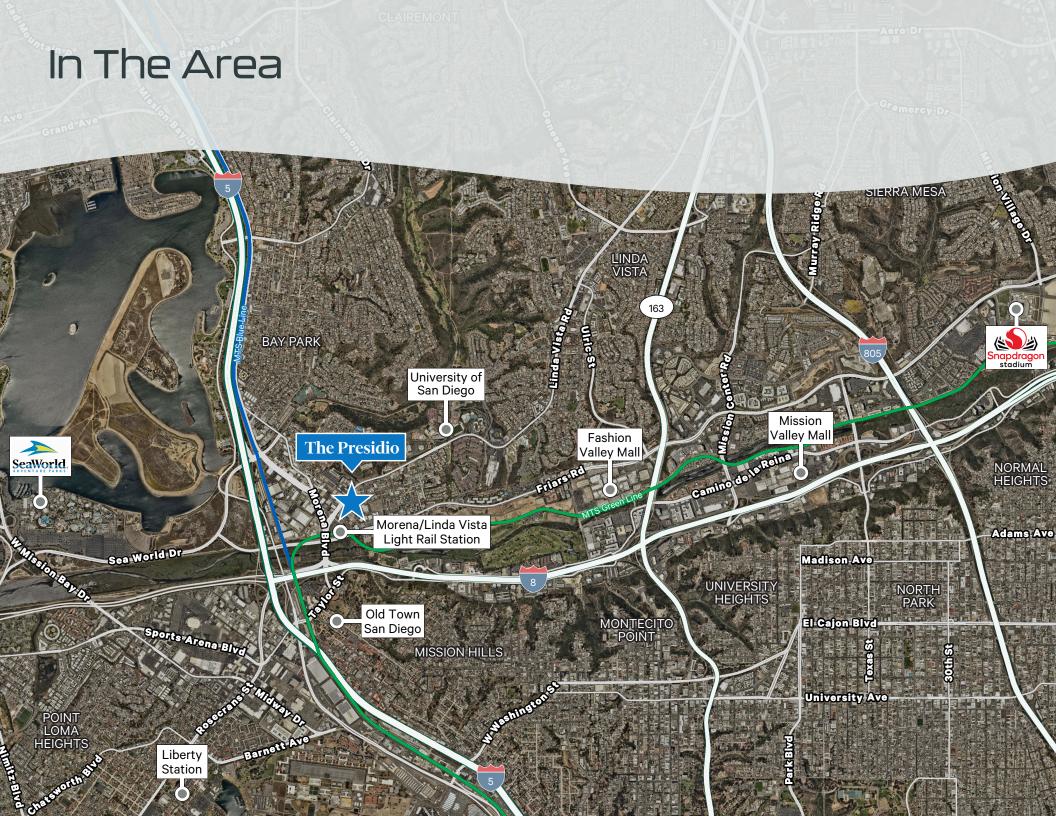
